



Monitored 3G Personal Alarms

Where to Buy

These are monitored alarms that use the 3G mobile network.

When they are activated, they dial out using the mobile phone network to a 24hr monitoring center.

Discounts and Subsidies

Some suppliers provide a discount if you are referred by a doctor, health professional or have a concession card. Check with the supplier before you buy.

Some service providers may subsidise personal alarms for their clients. For details, contact your service provider. If you hold a Department of Veterans' Affairs (DVA) card, you may be eligible for a personal alarm through the Rehabilitation Appliances Program (RAP). Contact DVA for details.

When a non-monitored alarm is activated, it dials your contacts directly (not a monitoring centre).

Non-Monitored Personal Alarms (3G)

These alarms use the 3G mobile phone network to dial out or use it as a backup.
